Bible Study

Monday

1 Sam. 3:1-10

1. What are you doing with your kids (or grandkids, nieces, nephews, etc.) so that they will grow up in an atmosphere of faith? What did you have, what have you seen, what has God put on your heart to implement in their lives?
2. Has there ever been a time when you realized later that you heard God speak, you just didn't recognize it? Have you learned from it, so that you are more accustomed to how He speaks to you? Do you make space for God to speak?

Tuesday

Psalms 139

1. Do you ever think about the fact that God knows every little thing about you and loves you anyway? How should that make us behave toward others?
2. How often do you think about/talk to God during the day? Do you think about the fact that He is always right there with you? How does that make you feel?
3. God thinks a lot of thoughts about you. What do you think they are? Does it sound like they are positive or negative?

Wednesday

1 Cor. 6:12-20

1. Is there something in your life that has the power over you, that you can't live without? What are you doing about it?
2. Do you really believe that God is right about sex, or is the world right about it and the Bible just old-fashioned? If God is right, are you destroying yourself by the way you are living?
3. Do you live as though your life belongs to Jesus, or, do you own your life and just give Jesus a few minutes each day or week?

Thursday

John 1:43-51

1. Are you actually following Jesus, or just using Him for insurance against Hell? What do you think it would look like to follow Jesus?
2. Who are the people that are responsible for bringing you to Christ? Have you ever said thank you? Have you targeted some people to help bring to Jesus? Are you praying for them and being a witness to them?
3. Do you believe that you will see greater things than you have already seen in your Christian walk, or, have you settled into a routine where you are just waiting on Heaven?

Friday

Joel 1:11-20

1. When things go wrong, do you repent for your part in making them that way, or get mad at God for letting it happen?
2. When you are caught in a mistake, do you take responsibility, or do you make excuses? Which one do you think pleases God?
3. Have you ever run from God when things got bad because you were embarrassed? Or, do you run to God as the only One who can help?

Saturday

Prov. 15:23-28

1. Have you ever had someone say just the right thing at the right moment and make all the difference in your life? Who are you encouraging to bring life to them?
2. Do you remember a time when you just had to have a thing or a promotion or some financial benefit and it made a mess at your house? Do you seek God when it comes to those types of decisions?
3. Are you too quick to give people a "piece of your mind"? Do you think before you speak about how this will affect people, is it in love, will it honor God?
