Monday

Jonah 3:1-10

1. The people of Nineveh believed God and began changing their actions. How has your faith in God affected your actions, specifically?
2. God saw their change of heart and changed His mind about destroying them. In other words, God responds to the way we respond to Him. Do you blame God for situations that you have caused? Do you have relationship with a living God, or just a fixed idea who can't respond?

Tuesday

Psalms 62

1. The word "wait" means to sit still and silently. How well do you sit still and be quiet? Do you need noise and distraction? Do you have peace of soul? Are you practicing this?
2. The end of designing evil against another person is destruction, according to the writer. Have you been plotting evil against another? What kind of person does it make you?
3. How much importance do you put in someone's position in life? Do you demand special treatment because of your position sometimes?

Wednesday

1 Cor. 7:29-35

1. How distracted are you with the things of this world? What is it that has your attention when it should be on God?
2. What do you have that drains you the most? It demands your time, attention, and resources, and leaves you feeling wrung out. What should you do about it?
3. Do you really believe that the way that the world lives is coming to an end? Have you lived through any major cultural changes? Or, do you live like nothing is ever going to change?

Thursday

Mark 1:14-20

1. Why do you think that Jesus waited until after John had been put in jail before He started traveling and preaching the Kingdom? Do you think the tough things that have happened in your life might have a bigger meaning?
2. What have you left or laid down to more effectively follow Jesus? Is your life better now because of it?
3. What is God making you into? Are you making progress toward becoming that?

Friday

Amos 8:1-7

1. Does God ever speak to you through everyday moments or things, a basket of fruit, a movie, a song, the behavior of the people around you?
2. We often hear about how good God wants our life to be. Do you take His warnings as seriously?
3. If God looked at your dealings with the poor and needy, what would He say to you? Are some people beneath you? Do failures at life turn you off?

Saturday

Prov. 15:29-33

1. What kind of listener are you? Do you take advice, or do you already have all the answers?
2. Do you live a self-disciplined life, or are you at the mercy of your feelings to decide what you will do every day? Why do you think it matters to God?
3. Do you promote yourself, honor yourself? Do you always tell about what you have, what you have done? Do you tell a better story than the one someone else just told?
