

Bible Study

Monday

Deut. 18:15-22

1. Moses is preparing the people for the coming of Jesus. How has God prepared you for things that were coming over the years? Is He doing that now?
2. He plainly told them that not listening to this prophet would end in death for them. Do you think listening to God is really that important? Can you tell it by your choices? Is it fair that their fate is decided this way?
3. Have you had people that spoke in God's name but it didn't come to pass or didn't ring true in your heart? Are you still intimidated by their position? Do you know someone that abuses people with their position of power? Do you do that?

Tuesday

Psalms 111

1. Have you ever thought about the fact that God made a covenant with you and that He will not break it because He won't lie? How does that affect the way you live?
2. His commandments are a solid foundation for life. How exactly are you building on this foundation? Can you give specific examples of how you are choosing God's way over your own ideas?
3. What do you think "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom" means? Are you afraid of disappointing God, or, do you take it for granted He will let you get by with whatever you want?

Wednesday

1 Cor. 8

1. Knowledge blows up your ego but love builds up people. Which are you known for? Are you someone that insults others because you know better or builds them up because you love them?
2. Do you have trouble believing that God is not petty over religious details? Has your faith made you more free or more in bondage and worry?
3. Have you ever considered that to sin against another Christian is actually to sin against Jesus? Do you think He is pleased with the way you treat the people He loves?

Thursday

Mark 1:21-28

1. Jesus astounded the people because He didn't teach like the religious leaders in their culture. What religious habits are you tied to? Do you insist on cultural things at the expense of souls? Are we more tied to a certain type of service or to our Savior?
2. Have you ever known someone in church whose actions were more driven by the Devil than by God? Has that person ever been you?
3. Are you intimidated by demonic activity and try to avoid thinking about it? Or, do you believe that Jesus really does have powers over demons and they are not to be feared?

Friday

Amos 8:8-14

1. Do you think America has sins that God needs to judge us for? Do you pray for forgiveness and guidance for our country and its leaders?
2. Do you think that our country is at a place where we have a famine of hearing God's Word? What can you do about it?
3. Do you see a lot of people wandering around without any purpose or idea of how to live? What about you? Are you living on purpose or wandering?

Saturday

Prov. 16:1-5

1. Do you know people who insist that they are right, but everyone knows they are wrong? Are you ever like that? Do you think you give yourself too much mercy sometimes?
2. Do you really believe that you can build a foundation for your thoughts and emotions by committing your future to God? Why would it work or not work?
3. The word "abomination" is the same word that God used when He told Israel to drive the Canaanites out of the Promised Land because of the "abominations". Do you think God is right to hate pride that much? Why? Do you hate pride when you find it in yourself?
