**Ps 78:40,41**

**Ps.78:40,41 DEFINITIONS OF KEY WORDS**

**Limited:** to set a mark or boundary, border, to confine within certain bounds, restrict; to grieve.

**Provoke:** rebel, defy, disobey, resist. **Grieve:** to cause pain or displeasure. **Turned back:** turn away, turn around, withdraw. **Tempted:** test, try by critically appraising Him.

**CONDEMNED:** JUDGED AGAINST, PRONOUNCED GUILTY.
